The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools Beginning Teacher Support Program (BTSP) is implemented with the intent of ensuring that our beginning teachers have every opportunity to attain success. It is the desire of CMS to provide the support needed to ensure success and improve student retention. All teachers who hold initial (Standard Professional I) licenses are required to participate in a three year induction period with a formal orientation, mentor support, observations and evaluations prior to the recommendation for continuing (Standard Professional II) licensure. CMS is committed to a school-based service mentoring model that is implemented throughout the district.
