

# **CMS 2009-2010 School Boundary Options Public Engagement Meeting Northeast Region**

**Newell Elementary  
October 6, 2008**

Purpose: to obtain meaningful feedback from parents and community residents on boundary options. CMS staff will present boundary options and the reasoning behind the options, listen and record input, answers questions and clarify boundaries. Parents and community residents will share perspectives, ideas and reactions to the boundary options.

Discussion: boundary options for-

- new Salome Church Road elementary, opening 2009-2010 school year  
-Schools possibly impacted: University Meadows, Newell and Hidden Valley elementary schools
- new Ridge Road middle, opening 2009-2010 school year  
-Recommendation to amend adopted 2009-10 new ridge road boundaries to align with adopted 2008-09 elementary school boundary

Each person attending received process timeline, maps of boundary options for each new school and demographic datasheets for each option.

The staff members meet with individuals at each table and discussed that the maps are options for “new Salome Church Road” and the amendment for “new Ridge Road” middle. The maps and datasheets are provided as a starting point for discussions/options. It was explained that several things are taken into consideration when creating the boundary options.

At each table, the process timeline was shared —

- Public engagement meetings are held during September & October
- October 14 - Boundary recommendations report is presented to the School Board\*
- November 12 – Public hearing and School Board vote\*
