Expectations for the School

iMeck Academy is based on three pillars of career and college preparedness: blended learning, work based learning, and leadership development. Blended Learning is a formal approach to education in which a student learns at least in part through online delivery of content, with some element of student control over time, place, path and/or pace. Students benefit from both online learning and face-to-face instruction in each of their courses within a technology rich environment. Students are introduced to various career options, have the opportunity to network with business leaders, and gain real-life experience through internship opportunities.

Expectations for the Teacher

Teachers in iMeck Academy will participate in professional development in order to effectively teach in a blended learning environment, while addressing the standards, goals, and objectives of the Common Core State Standards / NC Essential Standards. Interdisciplinary planning and flexible learning spaces will further enhance the student’s educational experience.

Expectations for the Student/Family

iMeck students are expected to demonstrate conscientious academic effort by regularly completing assignments on time and by participating constructively in lessons, activities, leadership development exercises and internship opportunities. Students should be self-motivated, natural problem solvers with technology tools who ask for help when needed, turn in work on time, work well with other students, take pride in quality of work, stay focused during class, manage time well, and exhibit leadership qualities. Students will be expected to fulfill minimum course requirements related to the magnet theme in order to maintain active status and to continue to the next grade level in the magnet program.
