Key Considerations for Covid Breakdown Report:

- The data reflected in this report assess weekly counts of confirmed cases associated with students learning in-person in EC, Pre-K and K-5 schools, and all staff including other district sites.
 - We work very closely with Mecklenburg County Public Health Department and follow the Communicable Diseases Reporting requirements.
 - Direct notification and instructions are provided to families of any students and staff who have been identified as a close contact*.
 - Please continue to help us keep our schools and community healthy by wearing a face covering, staying 6 feet apart, and washing your hands.
