**Establish a Home School Attendance Area for
Marie G. Davis K - 8 School and
Change the Attendance Boundaries for
Sedgefield Elementary and Sedgefield Middle Schools**

I move approval of the Superintendent's proposal, effective with the 2018-2019 school year, to create a home school attendance area for Marie G. Davis K-8 School that will include the portions of the Sedgefield Elementary and Sedgefield Middle school attendance areas south of Remount Road, west of South Tryon Street, north of Clanton Road and east of Interstate-77.

Details of the Proposed Changes

1. Projected Effective Date
Beginning of the 2018- 2019 school year
2. Affected Areas
The portions of the Sedgefield Elementary and Sedgefield Middle school attendance areas south of Remount Road, west of South Tryon Street, north of Clanton Road and east of Interstate-77.
3. Middle School Assignment
Marie G. Davis will serve grades K - 8. Home school students formerly assigned to Sedgefield Middle will attend Marie G. Davis for middle school.
4. High School Assignment
There is no change in the high school continuation school. Students living in the home school area for Marie G. Davis will be assigned to Myers Park High for high school.
5. Default Assignment for rising 5th, 7th and 8th grade students at Sedgefield Elementary and Sedgefield Middle schools(for the 2018-2019 school year)

6. Effect on Magnet Program at Marie G. Davis
The countywide full magnet International Baccalaureate magnet program is scheduled to begin at Marie G. Davis in the 2017-2018 school year (established by action of the Board on November 9, 2016). With this motion, Marie G. Davis will continue as a countywide partial magnet school with a school-wide International Baccalaureate theme.
