**Superintendent's Recommendation**

**Change Attendance Boundaries for  
Reid Park K-8 School and Renaissance West STEAM Academy**

May 24, 2017

I move approval of the Superintendent's proposal, effective with the 2018-2019 school year, to modify the home school attendance area for Renaissance West STEAM Academy to include the portion of the Reid Park K-8 home school attendance area that is north of West Boulevard and west of Old Steele Creek Road.

The Board previously assigned a portion of the Berryhill K-8 attendance area to Renaissance West STEAM Academy. Berryhill will continue to serve its remaining students across grades K-8.

**Details of the Proposed Changes**

1. Projected Effective Date  
Beginning of the 2018- 2019 school year
  
2. Affected Areas  
Students living in the portion of the Reid Park K-8 home school attendance area that is north of West Boulevard and west of Old Steele Creek Road will be assigned to Renaissance West STEAM Academy. This is a slight modification to the attendance boundaries for Renaissance West that were adopted by the Board in November 2015.
  
3. Default Assignment for all rising 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students at Reid Park K-8  
Students in grades K – 6 in the affected area will be assigned to Renaissance West beginning with the 2018-2019 school year. Students in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades in the affected area will be assigned to Wilson Middle School for the 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 school years, only. Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, all students in the affected area will attend Renaissance West for middle school.
  
4. High School Assignment  
Students in the affected portion of the Reid Park K-8 home school area will continue to Harding University High School. (This is not a change for these students.)
