

Comprehensive Progress Report

Mission:

To provide every Hopewell Titan with an engaging learning atmosphere rich with high expectations and school pride that will cultivate success beyond high school.

Vision:

To be a student-centered high school committed to helping students reach their full potential.

Goals:

100% of Hopewell High School students will graduate with their cohort with a plan for post-high school career and college options. School Counselors meet with students on a semester basis to review courses and academic progress and assist students in creating an Academic Planning Portfolio.

All Hopewell High School sub-groups will show an increase of 5% growth for Career and College Readiness (CCR). This will apply to Math 1, Math 3, Biology, English 2 during the 2021-2022 school year.

Duty-Free Lunch The NC SBE’s statutory provision 115C-105.27 (b) (6) requires all schools to include a plan to provide a duty-free lunch period for every teacher on a daily basis for every teacher under G.S. 115c-1(a) (A4.06) In addition a duty-free instructional planning time is required for every teacher under G.S. 115-C=105.27 and 301.1 with the goal of providing an average of at least five hours of planning time per week, to the maximum extent that the safety and proper supervision of students may allow during regular contact hours.

Duty-Free Instructional Planning Time for Teachers The NC SBE’s statutory provision 115C-105.27 (b) (7) requires a plan to provide duty-free instructional planning time for every with the goal of providing an average of at least 5 hours of planning time a week. [Note that the statute referenced provides that all classroom teachers are to be provided duty-free instructional planning time during regular student contact hours, to the extent that the safety and proper supervision of student may allow. To allow dedicated time to teacher planning and time for emotional self-care and not require teachers to serve lunch duty.

Bullying Prevention Provide a positive school climate, under CMS regulation JICK-R, by promoting a safe learning environment free of bullying and harassing behaviors. Hopewell High School administration will aim to create an environment that is safe for learning and free of bully behaviors. 100% of students will read and sign anti-bully statement and participate in programming that promote bully awareness and anti-bully messaging.

During the 2021-2022 school year 100% of students will participate in weekly 7 Mindsets social emotional learning lessons.
