Goals:

Duty Free Lunch: To provide a duty-free lunch period for every teacher on a daily basis. ALIGN TO: A4.06

Duty-free planning: Provide a duty-free instructional planning time for every teacher under G.S.115C-105.27 and -301.1, with the goal of proving an average of at least five hours of planning time per week, with the maximum extent that the safety and proper supervision of students may allow during regular student contact hours. Bullying Prevention: Provide a positive school climate, under CMS regulation JICK-R, by promoting a safe learning environment free of bullying and harassing behaviors. ALIGN TO: A4.06

By June 15, 2024, Kennedy Middle School will increase grade level proficiency in English Language Arts from 40.5 to 51.1%, Math from 33.4% to 56.2%, Math I from 90.4% to 100%, and Science from 64.6% to 72% on End-of-Grade and End-of-Course assessments. Aligned to A2.04 and A4.01

By the Spring Panorama Survey 2022, Kennedy Middle School will increase overall domain scores in Emotional Regulation, Sense of Belonging, and Cultural Awareness and Action. Emotional Regulation (41% to 45%) Sense of Belonging (42% to 45%) Cultural Awareness and Action (57% to 60%) Aligned to A4.06
