Mission:

Goals:

Provide a duty-free lunch period for every teacher on a daily basis, as safety and covid measures allow. (A4.06)

Provide a positive school climate, under CMS regulation, JICK-R, by promoting a safe learning environment free of bullying and harassing behaviors. (A4.06)

Provide a duty-free instructional planning time for every teacher with the goal of providing an average of at least five hours of planning time per week. (A2.01)

The percentage of Black and Hispanic 3rd-grade students combined who will score at the College and Career Ready (CCR) level --a 4 or 5-- on the English Language Arts (ELA) EOG will increase from 20% in SY 2021-22 to 50% in SY 2023-24. SY2022-2023 Target: 35% (A2.04, B3.03, and CMS Goal 1).

We will meet or exceed expected Educator Value-Added Assessment System (EVAAS) growth for our overall school index in SY2022-23 and SY2023-24 (A4.01, B3.03, and CMS Goal 4).

The percentage of students reporting a positive self-perception of their self-efficacy, self-management, and/or engagement will increase from % on the Fall Panorama screener (grades 3-5) to % in SY 2022-23 and % in SY 2023-24 (A4.06 and CMS Guardrail 3)

Out-of-School Suspension disproportionately for Black students will decrease from 73% in SY 2021-22 to 20% in SY2023-24. SY2022-23 Target: 50% (A4.06 and CMS Guardrail 1)
