II. OPPORTUNITIES: SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

The average AP score of all Levine students taking an AP exam with a CMS instructor will increase from 2.77 (2021) to 3.0 during the 2022 AP Exam administration. (A2.04, A4.01, B3.03)

100 % of Levine Middle College High School 11th graders will earn a cumulative Central Piedmont Community College GPA of 2.0 or higher for the 2021-2022 school year. (E1.06, A4.01)

Levine Middle College High School students (all grades, overall) will earn an average GPA of 3.2 or above in their Central Piedmont Community College classes during the 2021-2022 school year. (A4.06)

III. CHIEF CHALLENGES

- One of our main challenges is getting real-time progress reports on how our students are doing academically in their CPCC classes. We often do not get information until the end of the semester if our students are struggling in their college courses.

IV. PLANS FOR THE YEAR: SIP ACTIONS

- One of our high-level school improvement plan actions is to get better information in a more timely fashion regarding our students' progress in their CPCC classes. Through the new Aviso platform, or through the use of individual student FERPA waivers, our support staff is working to intervene and support students who are struggling in their CPCC classes during the semester (before it is too late to improve). Our goal is for all Levine Middle College students to receive a minimum 2.0 GPA for their CPCC classes.
