



K–2 Virtual School Option

CMS has had Virtual School option for students in grades 3–12 since the beginning of the school year. As of October 4, 2021, the district will offer medically fragile students in grades K–2 the opportunity to attend virtual school.



Who can apply?

This is for medically fragile students only. Families must provide documentation signed by a licensed medical provider attesting to students' medical fragility. The virtual option for K–2 students does not apply for non-medically fragile students living in households with other medically fragile individuals.



Why only medically fragile?

CMS believes that curriculum is best taught in-person, and the fundamental skills developed in these early grades serve as the foundation for successful learning throughout students' educational careers. This option is limited to those for whom attending in-person is a greater health risk than the risk of reduced mastery of critical educational concepts.



When can I apply?

Families may sign up K–2 students from October 4 – 10, 2021. Students who register after October 10 may not have registration processed before the November 1 first day of K–2 virtual school and likely will be unable to start attending virtual school by that date.

CMS is still working to move students in grades 3–12 from the wait list to virtual school.
