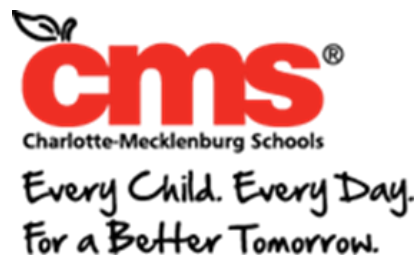
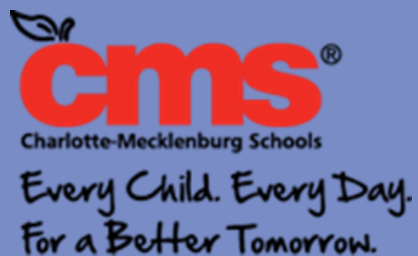

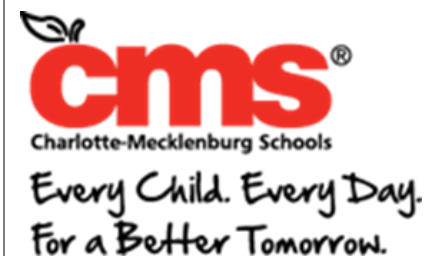

Crossing Guard Duties

School crossing guards are responsible for performing routine pedestrian assistance in the vicinity of an elementary or middle school. Assures school children are kept out of harm's way at designated road



intersection before and/or after school.

Guides school children across streets within the crosswalk.

Ability to control a STOP paddle effectively to alert approaching vehicles that they are to stop and yield to student and adult pedestrians

Ability to recognize potentially dangerous traffic situations and warn & manage students in sufficient time to avoid injury.

Keeps accurate count of children crossing during their shift.

Working conditions are primarily in an outside environment with exposure to temperature extremes, dust, and noise.

Dependability and punctuality.

Applicants will need to provide a minimum of three (3) supervisory references from your work history.

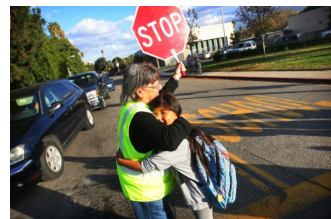
References cannot be from friends, co-workers or relatives.
